From Odessa Promotions Pty.Ltd.;

The Shire Secretary read a letter received from Odessa Promotions Pty.Ltd., which related to Council resolution at its last meeting that re-affirmed its opposition to the holding of a further Pop Festival.

The letter from Odessa Promotions was based on the assumption that Council had made its decision because of its concern for the effect on neighbouring landowners and a number of observations based on that assumption were set out. The letter urged Council to reconsider its attitude and asked that if there is any objection of any substance on any ground, that they once again be given the opportunity to reply to those objections.

After some discussion, it was proposed by Cr.Dumbrell, seconded by Cr.Chrystie, that letter from Odessa Promotions Pty.Ltd., be received.

It was suggested by Cr.Dumbrell, and agreed to by Council that the letter to be written to the Chief Secretary stating Council's opposition to the holding of a further Pop Festival should include the argument that the great number of police required at the Festival Site cannot really be spared when there is already a ^{shortage} of police on the roads and for normal police duties.
