Dear Mr. Shepherd,

Accompanied by the Country Fire Authority Regional Officer, I made an inspection of the section of your property adjoining the neighbouring property upon which it is proposed to conduct the "Sunbury Summer Happening" during the weekend 29th, 30th and 31st January, 1972.

In view of the circumstances, it is recommended, and I am informed by your wife with whom I spoke during the visit, it is your intention to do so, that a fire break be provided on the top of the ridge on the southern boundary of your property.

It is considered that a fire break in the vicinity of 2 chains wide, will not only offer protection to the patrons attending the "Happening" but will afford protection to your property in the event of a grass fire within this area.

Unfortunately I shall be absent from the office on leave, but Mr. C. Busse (Tel.: 744 1340) will indicate to you perhaps more precisely the recommended position of the fire break.
