Re: Sunbury Summer Happening.

As you know, we act for Odessa Promotions Pty. Ltd., which is the promoter of the abovementioned Festival. We write to you on the understanding that you are the "Proper Officer" appointed pursuant to the provisions of the Country Fire Authority Act 1958 (as amended). We believe that you will be aware of the attitude adopted by the Country Fire Authority towards the holding of the Festival, both by virtue of its letter of 31st. December to you and from press publicity.

The major cause for concern by the Authority is, we believe, based upon the consequences of there being a "running fire" in particular climatic conditions outside the Festival site. Obviously, one of the means of suppressing such a fire would be the provision of fire breaks on the properties adjoining the Festival site. Such provisions will need to be made as a matter of some urgency and accordingly we can but urge you to give this matter your most immediate attention.
